General Items

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Class-Specific Items

Spanish

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Math & Science

Students will use their green 3-ring binders to organize course material for Biology, Physical Science, Basic Math, and/or Spanish. ICS will provide binders for Chemistry, Algebra I, and Algebra II, as these binders contain materials that also serve as textbooks.

- Students should bring:
 - 1 ream (500 sheets) of unlined copy/printer paper *per subject*, i.e., one ream for Algebra, 1 ream for Chemistry, 1 ream for Trigonometry, 1 ream for Physics
 - #2 wooden pencils (no mechanical pencils, as these break, jam, and run out of graphite)
 - Erasers
 - **For Consumer Math and Physical Science:**
 - 1 folder for each subject
 - **For Chemistry, Trigonometry, and Physics only:**
 - A scientific calculator with trigonometric, log, and exponential functions (*available at most department stores for under \$10.00.*)
- Students do not need the following items, which ICS will provide or loan out:
 - Organization tabs for major sections in binders
 - Graph paper
 - Flash cards for recording terms to be memorized
 - Straight edge for Geometry, Trigonometry, and Chemistry (loaned out)
 - Compass for Geometry and Trigonometry (loaned out)
 - Drawing templates for Algebra, Calculus, and Physics (loaned out)
- Students should not bring:
 - Spiral-bound notebooks – *Only 3-ring binders will be used to organize class material.*
 - Trapper keepers or other large storage items – *These are not practical due to limited storage space.*
 - Calculators other than the one noted above – *Calculators are not used in Algebra or Geometry. Graphing calculators are not used in Calculus, although calculus students will be taught how to use them.*

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- Lined loose-leaf paper – *We do not use lined paper for math, physics, or chemistry problem solving. Students will use lined paper in Grammar & History classes.*

Grammar & History

Students will use their blue 3-ring binders to organize their Grammar, History, Literature, Speech, and Composition course materials.

- Multiple reams (500 sheets) of college-ruled, lined loose leaf paper (8½" x 11") – *Students will need a lot of this during the year. Please buy several reams. Papers with “frilly” ripped-out edges will not be accepted.*
- #2 wooden pencils (no mechanical pencils, as these break, jam, and run out of graphite)
- Erasers
- Black ballpoint pens
